






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DRBizNet History


- 2001 Initial vision published i Power Economics
- 2004 R&D begins as a project funded through ETD ar PIER, managed by CIE
- 2005 Prototype demonstrated to CA stakeholders
- 2006 Statewide demonstratic between CAISO, utilitie and demand aggregate
- 2007 UISOL begins DRBizNet commercialization
- 2008 PJM signs as first customer, CAISO installs version in their DR Lab
- 2009 DRBizNet goes live at PJM (in June)






Background: DR at PJM

Largest integrated energy and DR market in the world








PJM's Key Challenge: Growth of DR

Side Effects: Complexity and Change

PJM was out-growing their in-house DR management software




- More DR products, each with different business rules
 - Economic, emergency, and ancillary service programs
 - Qualification, enrollment, events, and settlements are all different
 - Workflow processes can span multiple organizations and systems
 - Market and regulatory forces driving continuous change
- More DR resources, becoming smaller and more varied
 - Each resource has different attributes, contacts, history, and availability
 - Desire to aggregate smaller resources to meet participation levels
 - Need for lower-barrier communication channels (email, web, voip)
 - Goal to reduce administrative effort and costs per resource enrollment
- More DR transactions, as the demand side substitutes for generation on a more daily basis
 - Need to streamline event-meter-settlement lifecycle
 - Need to centralize and automate baseline calculations for improved efficiency, accuracy, and audit-ability



DRBizNet: Provides PJM Scalability

Transparency and execution of larger work-queues

- ✓ Streamlined user-interface
- ✓ Complete web-services interface for heavy users
- ✓ Register resources for multiple DR programs
- ✓ Support aggregation of smaller retail resources
- ✓ Consolidated notifications
- ✓ Automated M&V and baseline calculations
- ✓ Automated settlements and adjustments
- ✓ Administrative reports






DRBizNet: Provides PJM Flexibility

Supporting new business rules and market opportunities

- Manages the complete DR process lifecycle
- ✓ Handles multiple DR programs, resource types, event types, and baseline rules
- ✓ Supports dynamic, product specific business rules and multi-party workflows
- ✓ Integrates existing systems using open protocols
- ✓ End-to-end process visibility and control

DRBizNet at PJM

- Project started in July 2008, went live in June 2009
- 1100+ users from 250+ organizations managing over 7000+ resources
- Used successfully all summer, participant feedback has been positive
- Already have new regulatory and business rule change requirements

DRBizNet at CAISO

- Installed in the CAISO DR Lab to manage demo programs and events
- Communicates with Akuacom DRAS and other open devices
- UISOL is helping CAISO plan opening a wholesale DR market in 2010
- DRBizNet also part of DOE stimulus grant proposal by CAISO and PG&E

DRBizNet roadmap for other ISOs, utilities, aggregators

- Expand support of distributed resource types and parameters
- Enhance communication with open ADR, AMI, and HAN technologies
- Further automation of registrations, notifications, M&V, and settlements
